1718

Early Apprenticeship

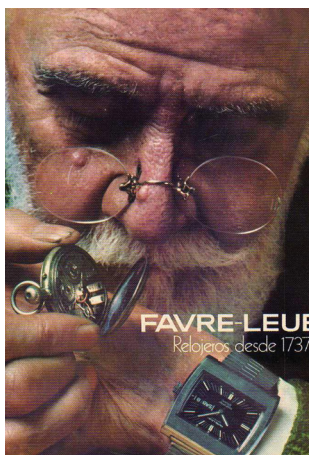
Abraham Favre (1702-1790) began his watchmaking apprenticeship with watchmaker Daniel Gagnebin in 1718 when he was only 16.



1737

Independent Watchmaker

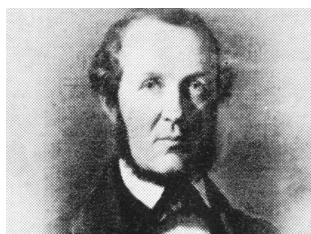
On March 13, 1737, in an official document, Abraham Favre was first mentioned as an independent watchmaker in Le Locle, laying the foundation of the company.



1815

Favre Leuba & Co.

The company subsequently grew. This expansion prompted Henry-Auguste Favre - the 4th generation of the Favre family - to join forces with Auguste Leuba.



1851

International Exhibitions & Awards

Favre Leuba pocket watches received many awards at national and international exhibitions - in London (1851), New York (1853), and Paris (1855) among others.



1962

Bivouac

Favre Leuba developed the legendary Bivouac, the world's first mechanical watch with an aneroid barometer for altimetry and air pressure measurement.

1964

Walter Bonatti & Michel Vaucher

The first mountaineers to summit the north face of the infamous Whymper Peak, wore the Favre Leuba Bivouac.

1964

Year of the Deep Blue

Three years after the first diver's watch was presented from the in-house atelier, the brand launched the Deep Blue, waterproof up to 200 metres.

1968

Exploring The Depths

In 1968, the brand introduced Bathy. It was the world's first mechanical dive watch with a depth gauge to measure the current dive depth.

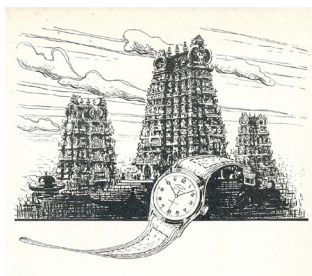

1865

Favre Leuba In India

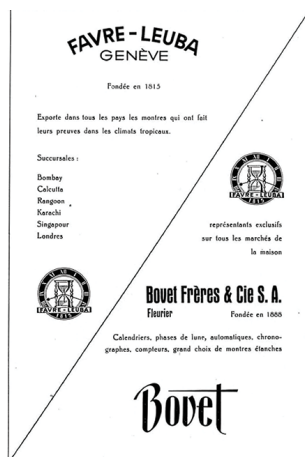
Favre Leuba became the first Swiss watch brand to enter India when Fritz Favre launched some of the house's popular timepieces there in 1865.



1946

Favre Leuba & Bovet

Favre Leuba acquired the name and manufacturing facilities of Bovet in 1946. For the next two years, the maison produced many high-precision chronograph watches.



1955

An Era Marked by Innovation

Favre Leuba introduced the Manufacture calibre FL101, with a large balance wheel for precise regulation and a 50-hour power reserve. It was first used in the Sea Chief, Sea King, and Sea Raider watches.



1962

FL250 & FL251 Calibres

Favre Leuba developed the FL251, extra thin (2.95mm), twin barrel calibre with a 50-hour power reserve. With this, it became one of the first brands to achieve series production of thin movements.



1969

Jaeger-LeCoultre

Favre Leuba purchases the SAPIC group, which owned Jaeger-LeCoultre at the time. Owned by George Favre, the sister companies produced many timepieces, like the Reverso.

1975

Junko Tabei

The first lady to stand upon the summit of Mount Everest wore a Favre Leuba Bivouac for this epic journey.

2017

Pen Hadow

The first person to sail the Central Arctic Ocean's furthest northern point ever traversed, equipped with the Raider Harpoon.

2018

Adrian Ballinger

Summited the highest peak in the world, Mount Everest, without oxygen support and a Favre Leuba Bivouac around his wrist.

THE CHRONOGRAPH CALIBRE

Favre Leuba brings an unparalleled sense of craftsmanship and mechanical savoir-faire with its chronograph calibres. The La-Joux Perret movements L113 with bi-compax anatomy powers the Chief Chronograph watches, while the L112 with tri-compax layout is used in the Sea Sky timepieces. These exceptionally reliable movements are equipped with a column wheel chronograph mechanism and feature a power reserve of 60 hours while delivering exceptional precision, beating at a 4Hz frequency.

At Favre Leuba, design supremacy is always at par with technical virtuosity, a philosophy that informs all our calibres. In a commitment to refined craftsmanship, the maison brings

beauty and elegance to the decoration of the movements, adorning every Favre Leuba calibre with surface finishes of remarkable nature. It radiates aesthetic sophistication with meticulously executed patterns, such as circular graining, Côtes de Genève, Soleillage, and more on various movement components. These details are proudly visible through the sapphire crystal caseback.

To complete the exquisite craftsmanship of our movements, Favre Leuba adds a distinctive finishing touch with a custom-made rotor. This gold-plated, skeletonised rotor is adorned with the Favre Leuba monogram and bears the proud inscription "Swiss Made Since 1737."

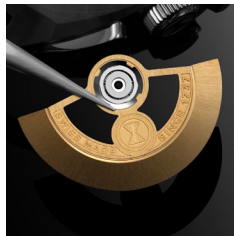
I. A SUPERIOR DRIVING FORCE

Designed and manufactured with high Swiss craftsmanship, the La-Joux Perret L113 & L112 are self-winding column-wheel chronograph calibres. A testament to unrivalled accuracy and reliability, the movement is equipped with a column wheel chronograph. It features a power reserve of 60 hours and delivers exceptional precision, beating at a 4Hz frequency.



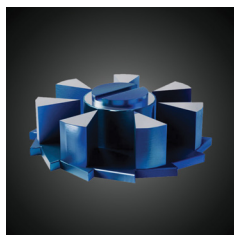
II. IMMACULATELY DECORATED CALIBRE

The watch offers a clear view of the immaculately decorated calibre through the sapphire crystal case-back. It carries superlative finishing on all the elements, meticulously executed with refined detail, such as Perlage on the lower bridges, Côtes de Genève on the main plate, Soleillage on the rotor, blued screws, column wheel and more.



III. SPECIALLY CRAFTED

The 4N PVD rotor is skeletonised and custom-designed with Colimmaçon & Soleillage finishes. The Favre Leuba monogram is engraved as a medallion along with the text 'Swiss made since 1737'. Skeletonisation of the rotor is an extremely precise task with more implications than just aesthetics. The weight and other characteristics of the rotor boast surgical precision to ensure winding efficiency.



IV. COLUMN WHEEL SUPREMACY

The movement features a column wheel mechanism to govern the chronograph function, which is considered to be superior, more precise and a lot more difficult to manufacture. Blueing is a result of a very precise heat treatment process which is used to increase the hardness. This process also results in the part turning to a stunning blue colour. Even the slightest imperfection can result in an imperfect and uneven blue finish. In that case, the watchmaker has to repolish and clean the part in order to start afresh.

THE AUTOMATIC CALIBRE

Imagined and manufactured at La-Joux Perret, the G100 calibre powers the Chief Date, Deep Blue Revival and Deep Blue Renaissance timepieces. Beating at a frequency of 4Hz, it offers an impressive power reserve of 68 hours and a date complication.

Favre Leuba steadfastly upholds the fundamental principle of watchmaking excellence, demonstrating an unwavering commitment to exceptional craftsmanship and mechanical expertise through its movements. The brand's philosophy is rooted in the harmonious balance of design supremacy and technical virtuosity, a guiding tenet that informs the creation of every calibre.

With a distinctive cushion-shaped case crafted from 316L stainless steel. This design exudes a sense of rugged elegance with sharp, angular lines, which are a direct nod to the vintage models. The case's contemporary proportions of 41mm diameter and only 14mm thickness for the chronograph and 40mm diameter with only 11mm thickness for the Chief Date. Complemented by a modern appeal and multifaceted design, it flaunts brilliantly executed finishes that add a beautiful contrast to the watch, showcasing our extraordinary craftsmanship. Both the Favre Leuba Chief Chronograph and Chief Date watches are proposed with an integrated two-link bracelet that unites seamlessly with the case and tapers towards the end, providing a graceful presence on the wrist. The bracelet also includes an easy change mechanism and is secure with a butterfly clasp. Alternatively, the watches are also available with a rubber strap, offering versatile wearing options.

The Favre Leuba Chief gets its most contemporary update in the form of the dial, which undergoes over 100 steps in production. The Chief Chronograph boasts a clean bicompass chronograph arrangement elevated by a sunray base finish, fine-turned circular brushed sub-dials, a 3D logo embedded in the dial, and an inner ring tachymeter. Meanwhile, the dial of a Chief Date produces a sense of dynamism with an intricately carved monogram pattern adorned with countless tiny Favre Leuba monograms. This distinct decoration creates an impressive play of light and texture upon the wrist's movement. Both versions of the Favre Leuba Chief offer a choice of three dial colours, two stunning shades of blue and a classic black. Additionally, all watches are powered by automatic movements with a generous power reserve.

REVITALISING THE ICONIC 1960s CHARM



CELEBRATING 60 YEARS OF *FAVRE LEUBA'S ICONIC DIVE WATCH*

Reviving the iconic spirit of the original 1964 Deep Blue, the new Favre Leuba Deep Blue collection redefines the essence of a dive watch by fusing timeless sophistication with cutting-edge performance. This collection brings remarkable dive watches, designed to honour maritime heritage of the brand while boldly embracing the future.

Today's Deep Blue collection consists of two distinctive models; the vintage-inspired Deep Blue Revival and the contemporary Deep Blue Renaissance. The Deep Blue Revival is a faithful reinterpretation of 1964 timepiece with vintage details like the 39mm case, a boxed sapphire crystal and a unidirectional bezel with a sapphire insert. Its dial brings back the design of the original in all its purity. The interesting placement of the brand logo and the Deep Blue name at nine and two o'clock positions is a remarkable throwback to the original, as are the extra-long quarter hour indexes. Together with the vintage-inspired five-link bracelet, these details make the Deep Blue Revival truly recognisable.

The Deep Blue Renaissance takes a more modern approach with three different coloured dials boasting a stunning dégradé effect. Each variation matches the colour of the ceramic diver's bezel with the dial. The watch wraps around the wrist with a three-link steel bracelet that boasts a brushed finish on the side links and polished centre links. Also available in an FKM rubber strap that complements the dial. Upholding the tradition of functional elegance, the dial of the Deep blue Renaissance boasts an interesting two-layered sandwich construction. It consists of a top layer, with perforated indexes, positioned over a base layer coated with Superluminova, resulting in bright, luminous hour markers. These markers, coupled with luminous hands, strengthen uninterrupted visibility underwater. The dial is equal part dressy, featuring vibrant blue, green, and grey hues with a nice gradient finish. A round date aperture is positioned discreetly between four and five o'clock for a clean, understated look and enhanced legibility.

Both the models are water resistant up to 300M and are powered by the La-Joux Perret G100 self-winding

movement. A testament to unrivalled accuracy and reliability, the movement is equipped with a date complication. It features a power reserve of 68 hours. It delivers exceptional precision, beating at a 4Hz frequency.

A double-domed sapphire crystal glass with an anti-reflective coating on both sides strengthens the watch's vintage appeal while ensuring optimum legibility.

A striking harmony exists between the case components—from the knurled crown flanked by polished pushers to the chamfered lugs—creating a sporty and clean silhouette. The tasteful combination of brushed and polished finishes adds depth and visual appeal. The case also features a flat sapphire glass caseback, treated with an AR coating on the inside, providing a clear view of the inner workings while maintaining the watch's 100-metre water resistance.

The classic dial of the Sea Sky carries pleasing vintage aesthetics with an understated matte finish, complemented by retro-inspired index hour markers and faceted hands. It features a clean tricompass chronograph configuration, with contrasting sub-dials that stand out against the dark backdrop for enhanced legibility. 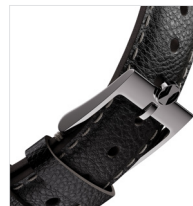
